## APPLYING THE 3' Rs TO WASTE REDUCTION

Here's some encouraging news for those of you unable to attend the joint meeting with **Darlington County LWV**, held February 20 at Florence-Darlington TEC. Armed with a huge bag stuffed with examples of various materials in the assorted stages of being reclaimed, **Josh Fowler** of **SONOCO Recycling**, **Inc.**, offered the following:

- 1. Sonoco operates three "material recovery facilities" (MRFs) in South Carolina-Columbia, Charleston and Greenville.
- 2. This new technology allows recyclables to be sorted at the facility, beginning with the consumer who separates recyclables from household garbage. In other words, paper, metal, glass and plastic can be put in one container for pick up, thus eliminating the need for a sorter on the collection truck.
- 3. All SC counties are not participating in this program. Fowler advised that it was best to check with your county of residence to determine what is actually being recycled.
- 4. The 3 R's of waste reduction? -- Reduce, Reuse, Recycle!
